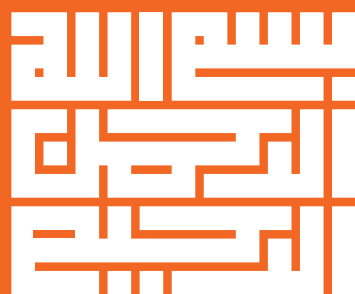




Partners of the World

The Launching

The National Shipping Company of Saudi Arabia, otherwise known as Bahri, was established by Royal Decree No. M / 5 issued on January 22, 1978 (Safar 12, 1398 AH) as a public joint-stock company listed on the Saudi Stock Exchange (Tadawul). The Public Investment Fund (PIF) owns 22.5 percent of the company, while the Saudi Aramco Development Company owns 20 percent. The remainder of the shares are owned privately by citizens and investment institutions.

Over the four decades since its establishment, Bahri has grown from a small shipping company with a fleet of four multi-purpose vessels into one of the largest transport companies in the world. Today, we own an extensive fleet of tankers and ships and are considered a leader of the global maritime sector.

Bahri provides its portfolio of services through an integrated network of global operations facilitated by 3,000 employees who are committed to meeting the needs of our customers. We are dedicated to achieving maximum results for our partners through the construction of vessels specially designed to provide integrated transportation services domestically and internationally. And we are always keen to provide pioneering sea, land and air services that offer added value by effectively utilizing the latest global technologies.

Bahri's commitment to innovation and applying best practice across its businesses has ensured the company continues to maintain its leadership position at the forefront of the maritime sector since launch. We have diversified our businesses and expanded into new markets to maintain our standing in the transport and logistics sectors, while a longstanding dedication to expansion has led to the development

of modern facilities such as a private container yard at Jeddah Islamic Port – plans are underway to establish a similar facility at King Abdulaziz Port in Dammam.

Today, we are the first national transportation company to complete more than 40 years of operations, and we aim to achieve more growth and success .

- Hyundai Mipo Dockyard (HMD) signs agreement with Bahri to build 10 chemical tankers.
- The National Grain Company is established as a joint venture between Bahri and the Saudi Agricultural and Livestock Investment Company (SALIC).
- Four new dry bulk carriers are delivered.

Bahri Oil was established in 1996 to meet the crude shipping needs of the Kingdom, which ranks second in the world in terms of oil production. Shortly after its founding, the company became the exclusive carrier of oil sold by Saudi Aramco in addition to securing long-term contracts with blue chip companies such as South Korea's S-Oil Company.

Bahri Oil has been at the forefront of the global oil shipping market for around two decades. A central component of the company's success is a large fleet of modern Very Large Crude Carriers (VLCCs) that it owns and operates. These high-quality vessels can each carry around 2.2 million barrels per voyage, while the total capacity of the fleet is 13.4 million deadweight tonnage (DWT).

Through its full understanding of market mechanisms, Bahri Oil is committed to ensuring that its customers and shareholders receive the best value possible. Through its ownership of a fleet of tankers, the company can demonstrate commercial and operational flexibility, an ability to introduce innovative operating models based on big data and an advanced marine routes management system that assists vessels in achieving a high level of efficiency. And of course, a highly qualified and experienced workforce is responsible for driving the company's operations.

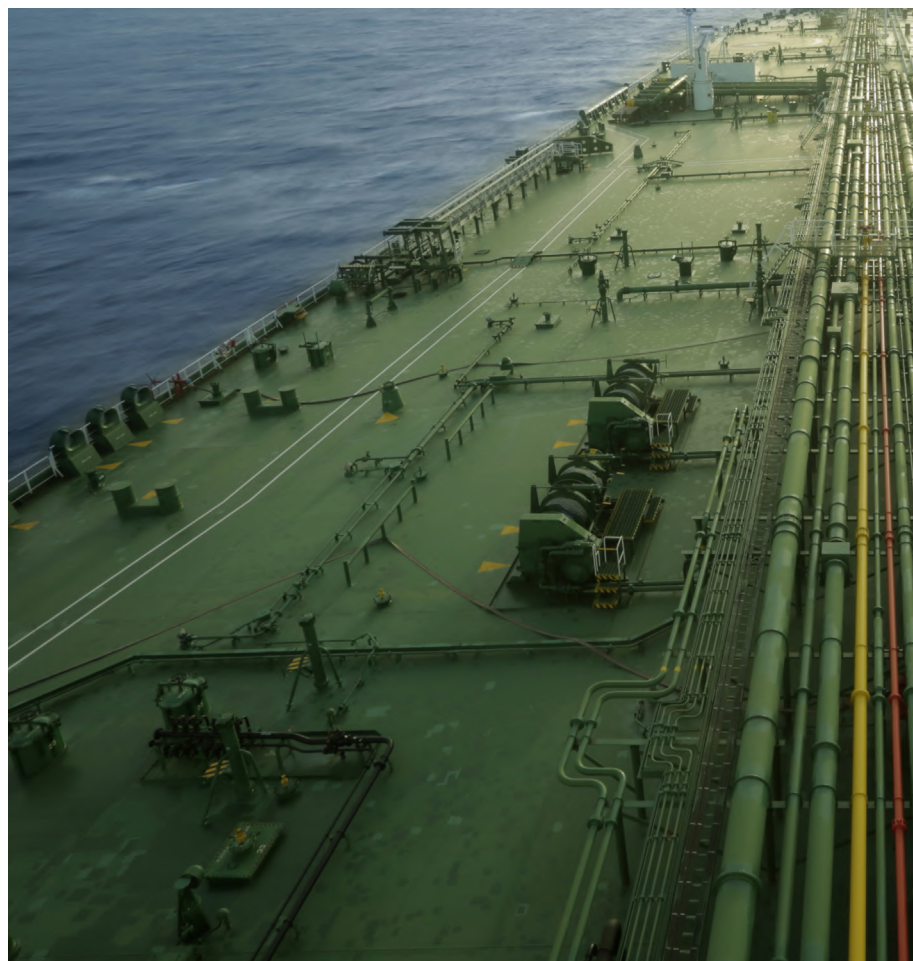

Bahri Oil's Fleet



Bahri owns a fleet of 41 VLCCs that it has developed over the past two decades.

At the beginning of 2017, the company received five tankers from South Korea's Hyundai Heavy Industries' shipyard, built in line with the latest international specifications.

In 2018, another five tankers were delivered to the company, with each vessel possessing an average cargo capacity of 2.2 million barrels of crude oil per voyage. These additions to the fleet have strengthened Bahri Oil's position as one of the largest owners and operators of tankers in the global oil market.

The company's oil tankers are designed to operate across all marine routes around the world and transport every type of crude. Vessels are designed to carry up to three different grades of crude oil, although additional grades can be carried when required by customers.

Bahri Logistics was established in 1979 as the first strategic company under the Bahri Group umbrella. Its long legacy extends for more than 40 years, over the course of which it has developed a tried-and-trusted approach to delivering highly efficient services for different types of shipments and specialized in providing storage capabilities “below the surface”.

The company is considered one of the top 10 cargo carriers in the world and one of the best five operating in European markets. It is the leading provider of transport services via direct shipping lines extending from the eastern coast of the United States, American Gulf Coast and Canada, to Jeddah, Dubai, Dammam and Mumbai. Bahri Chemicals is the largest owner and operator of chemical carriers in the Middle East. The company was established in 1990 as a joint venture between Bahri and SABIC, with the former owning 80 percent and the latter the remaining 20 percent. Today, it provides its services at 150 ports around the world.

Bahri Chemicals' fleet of 35 tankers meets the highest international specifications and can transport a wide range of chemical shipments with a combined capacity of 1.3 million DWT.

Since its establishment, Bahri Chemicals has been able to expand its customer base all over the world. The company operates 22 of its carriers on a fixed-term lease contract system, enabling it to maintain an optimal balance between its long-term and short-term contracts. 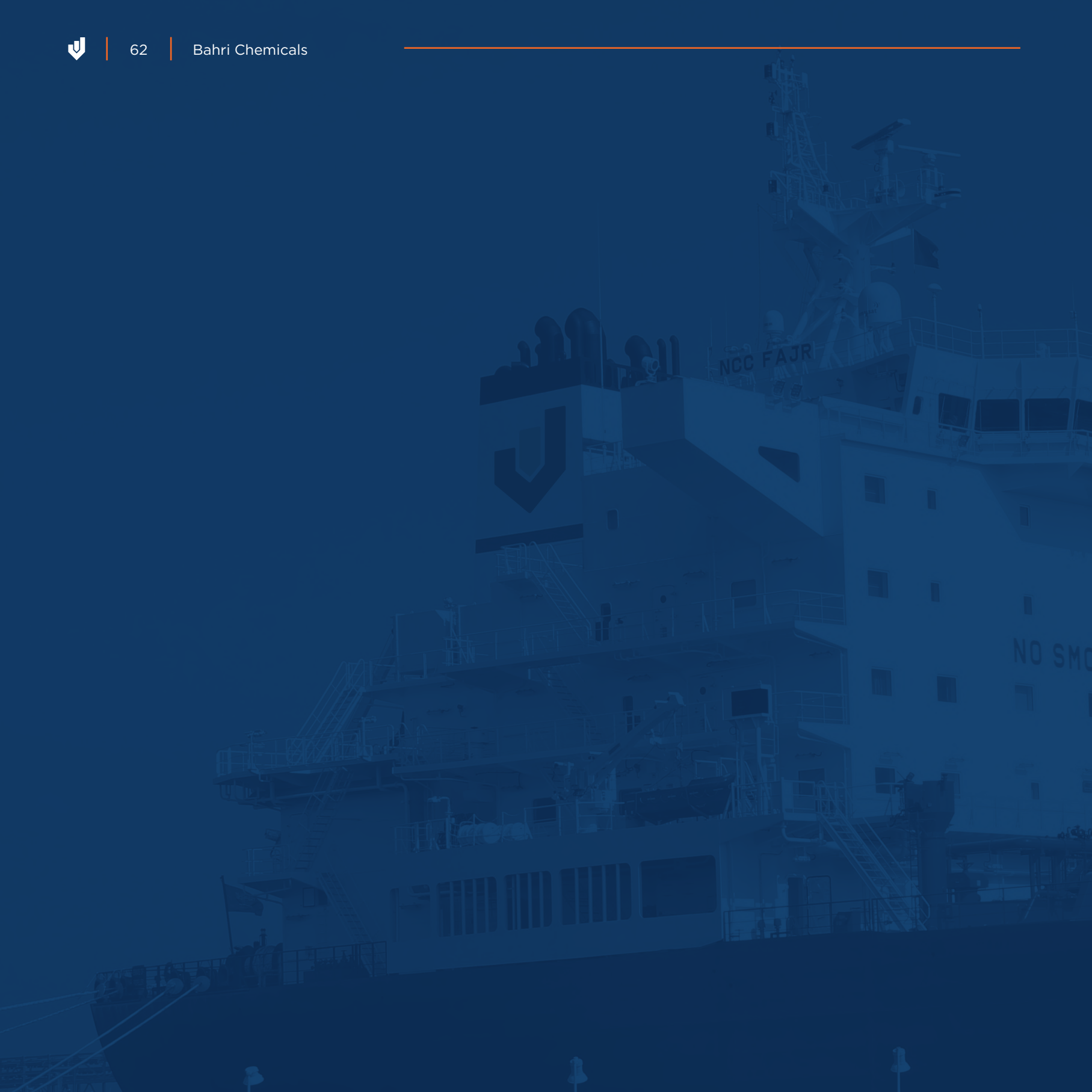

Bahri Dry Bulk operates nine vessels that possess excellent operational capabilities and fuel efficiency and transport up to 1.3 million tons of cargo annually from North and South American ports to Saudi Arabia.

Over the course of its operations, the company launched its new Operated Model business concept designed to enhance Bahri's position and brand in global markets. Bahri Dry Bulk is currently aiming to transport 10 million metric tons in a number of markets as part of ambitious expansion plans – the objective is to maintain ongoing efforts to sustain business growth and establish long-term partnerships with global players.

Bahri Dry Bulk handles operational and commercial operations including ship delivery, arrangements before and after a voyage, determining the agent at loading and unloading ports and arrangements for supplying vessel fuel. The company also communicates with ports, customs authorities and survey teams and monitors vessels' journeys around the clock.

Bahri Ship Management, known as Mid-east, was established in 1996 as a technical management company fully owned by the Bahri Group. The company's aim is to be the leading provider of technical and commercial services to Bahri ships operating in oil, chemicals, dry bulk and roll-on/roll-off goods.

The company is among the leaders in the maritime sector for having the lowest accident and injury rates on board ships and maintaining a fleet that meets the highest quality and safety standards. It consistently achieves high scores in assessments conducted as part of the Ship Inspection Report (SIRE) and International Maritime Organization's Port State Control (PSC) programs.

Bahri Ship Management applies the most stringent regulatory frameworks – International Safety Management Law (ISM), flag state law, port state monitoring and social classification rules. Its accreditations include: ISO 9001:2015, ISO 14001:2015 (environmental management), ISO 50001:2011 (energy management) The company is working to obtain the ISO 45001:2018 accreditation in occupational health and safety. 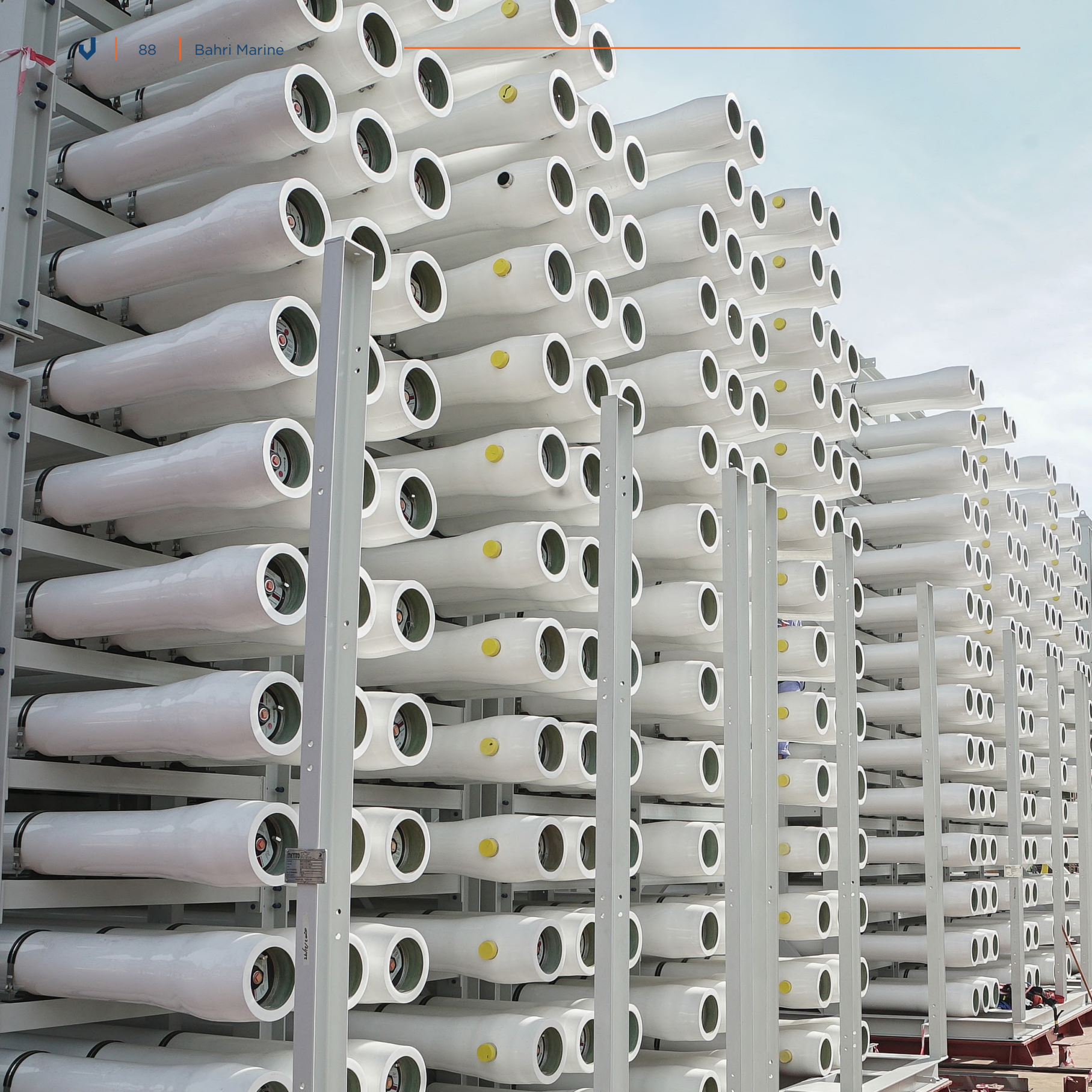
